Tasks start at 9.30am. Most end at about 4.30pm. Everyone welcome and your help will be valued for whatever time you can spare. Volunteers under 16 should be accompanied by a responsible adult. Between the ages of 16-18 volunteers will need consent from a parent/guardian. experience previous is necessary. Instruction in techniques and safe working practice will be given.

WHAT TO BRING

You'll need a packed lunch and a

mug, strong footwear (work boots, walking boots, or wellies for wet tasks), old warm clothes, and waterproofs. Sun protection is advisable (even in winter). We provide tools and protective gear, as well as tea and coffee.

HEALTH AND INSURANCE

Insurance cover is arranged for the group on task. An up-to-date anti-Tetanus injection is strongly advised for most outdoor activities. If you think you may not be covered on this other or other health issues, you are advised to consult a health professional.

New Boardwalk at Parndon Wood

This summer HCV have been hard at work installing a new boardwalk at Parndon Wood Nature Reserve. To ease public access and protect the habitat around the path the new boardwalk has been put in place in a series of tasks with help from the First Bus Group volunteers. The materials were bought with funding from the Wildspace project, a two year English Nature/Big Lottery/Harlow Council project to improve the local environment of Harlow.

This task will be completed with a further two-day task on the 14/15th October.






Sunday 29th October 2006: East End Wood Coppicing


Sunday 12th November 2006: Marsh Lane

Pond clearance and restoration

Go straight over the roundabout that leads to Churchgate street and after 300m look out for a small turning on the left. Turn onto Marsh Lane and drive to the end near to the Gibberd Garden. Parking will be provided in this area.

Sunday 26th November 2006: Holy Cross School


Hedge-laying

Hedge planting and fence building




